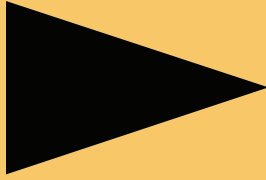

- Seek information from colleges
- Enter scholarship competitions
- Prepare for the SAT Reasoning Test
- Initiate the college-planning process

What's on the Test

The PSAT/NMSQT includes five sections:

- Two 25-minute critical reading sections
- Two 25-minute math sections
- One 30-minute writing skills section

The whole test requires two hours and 10 minutes.

Critical Reading

Two 25-minute critical reading sections = 48 questions

Math

Two 25-minute math sections = 38 questions

Students are advised to bring a calculator with which they are comfortable.

Writing Skills

One 30-minute writing section = 39 questions
